Reimagine the kitchen you *already* own.

Kitchen Refinement is for kitchens that need more than a change of cabinetry colour, but not a full renovation.

We reconsider the room as a whole - cabinetry, colour, hardware, worktops, tiles, lighting and selected joinery - then identify the changes that will make the greatest difference.

Nothing is replaced simply for the sake of it. Only the elements that genuinely improve how the kitchen looks, feels and functions become part of the project.

The result is a kitchen that feels entirely renewed, while preserving the quality and character already within it.

Selected bespoke joinery

Every new element is detailed in relation to what remains, allowing old and new work to sit naturally together.

A specialist finish for well-made cabinetry.

Well-made cabinetry deserves a finish of equal quality.

Your cabinetry is excellently spray finished. Doors, drawer fronts and removable panels are individually labelled, repaired and prepared before being finished and cured in our controlled Cardiff workshop. Fixed frames and non-removable elements receive the same methodical preparation in your home, with professional protection and extraction.

The coating system, colour and sheen are specified for the existing substrate and the demands of everyday kitchen use.

The result is a smooth, durable and consistent finish across the entire kitchen - one that looks integral to the cabinetry rather than simply applied over it.

A coordinated project, without the burden of managing it.

A wider refinement may involve several specialists. The responsibility for bringing their work together remains with us.

We establish the programme, coordinate access and brief each trade against the agreed design. You are not left chasing diaries, repeating decisions or resolving conflicting advice.

Each stage is prepared for the next, helping to reduce avoidable delays and disruption. Questions and changes are brought back through Bespoke rather than passed between separate contractors.

You have a clear understanding of what is happening, when it is happening and who is taking care of it.
